Addressing Greenhouse Gas Protocol

The GHG protocol is one of the most widely used standards and tools for calculating and measuring environmental footprint. GHG protocol classifies corporate emissions into 3 scopes to be reported on: Scope 1 (company vehicles: ICE), Scope 2 (company vehicles: EV), Scope 3 (supply chain emissions, business travel in non-company vehicles, and commuting).

New ESG disclosure regulations require more comprehensive reporting of GHG emissions, leading to companies not only striving to achieve carbon neutrality for their own operations, but to also set targets to reduce Scope 3 emissions. With EcoReport, your fleet can accelerate its efforts to reduce climate impact across Scope 1, 2, and 3.





Regulations At-A-Glance

In the landmark Paris Agreement adopted at the UN Climate Change Conference (COP21) in Paris, France, on December 12, 2015, many countries around the world committed to reach Net Zero by 2050. And this requires all organizations to step up for change.

Since then, many countries have introduced legislation to help achieve Net Zero, including:

EU

Sustainable Finance Disclosure Regulation (SFDR) – requires financial markets participants to disclose information regarding their ESG activities.

Corporate Sustainability Reporting Directive (CSRD) – aims to bring transparency and action plans to reduce environmental footprint.

Corporate Sustainable Due Diligence Directive (CSDDD) – aims to ensure that businesses operating in the EU take responsibility for their impact on people and the planet.

United States

Enhancement & Standardization of Climate-Related Disclosures for Investors (2022) – proposed, would require publicly traded companies to report on climate-related risk, including GHG emissions.

Greenhouse Gas Reporting Program (GHGRP) Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Mandatory Reporting of Greenhouse Gases Rule – requires large sources and suppliers in the US to report GHG emissions annually.

Australia

Climate related financial disclosure (2022) – enforces mandatory climate-related reporting obligations for the country's largest companies and financial institutions from July 1, 2024.

United Kingdom

Streamlined Energy and Carbon Reporting (SECR) – designed to provide greater transparency for investors, and other stakeholders, on business energy efficiency, and supports the transition to a low-carbon economy.
